In October 2010 , Mincon won worldwide publicity when it emerged that its MX5053 drill piece, designed at its Shannon plant, broke through the cavity where the miners had been trapped since August 22. The narrow hole it drilled through a half mile of rock established communication with the men and provided them with food, water and medical supplies before they were rescued.

Complete Coatings were again contacted recently by Mincon to offer some advice and consult on one of its many engineering workshop floors that needed to be upgraded to meet increased manufacturing requirements.

## ***€35m Critical Care Unit, Limerick Regional Hospital***

One of the largest capital projects the HSE is undertaking this year, a critical care facility will be built and attached to the existing hospital in Limerick. Overseeing the construction is John Sisk & Sons Ltd, the main contractor to the project. The unit will provide for intensive care with supporting accommodation- a 14 bed high dependency unit and a 16 bed coronary care unit as well.

The specification was to ISO standard and Jotun two pack epoxy and polyurethane coatings were the preferred coating system as proposed by Complete Coating Services.
